If you use a credit card, on the signature line write "See ID" so the cashier will require proof of your identity before swiping your card.

This holiday shopping season marks the one year anniversary of Target's data breach where up to 110 million people had their personal information stolen. To date, there are no arrests in that case.

A recent study from Experian reveals that of those planning to shop online this holiday season, nearly 40 percent still do not check to see if the site is secure. In store, only 41 percent of shoppers cover the PIN pad at the register when entering information available to anyone peering over the shopper's shoulder.

- Pay in cash
- Use prepaid cards
- Avoid debit cards (use of pin and direct link to bank account)
- Remove excess credit cards or check books from your wallet or purse
- Never carry your Social Security card with you
- Never shop using public WiFi
- Secure all your accounts using strong passwords that contain lower & upper case letters, numbers and a symbol
- Use encrypted websites such as those that begin with "https"
- Carefully review credit card and bank statements
- Ask your bank to set up fraud alerts on your accounts
- Ask your bank for a credit card with EMV chip technology (most are going to this technology but have not yet adopted it)
- Update your computer operating system.

Sony Breached, Sly Stalone Social Security Exposed

The most recent victim of a massive data breach is Sony. And, as the investigation continues, the breach seems to get worse. At first, Sony believed the breach was minor and only included budgets, layoffs and 3,800 Social Security numbers. Then, it believed it involved the theft of passwords. However, The Wall Street Journal just reported the breach is much worse.

According to the Wall Street Journal, over 47,000 Social Security numbers of present and former Sony employees were stolen. One such identity is that of famous actor Sylvester Stalone. The breach included Social Security Numbers along side addresses, salary information and more.
