HIPAA Breach Among Largest Ever Ever Reported

A cyber security attack on personal information including, social security numbers, birthdays, names, addresses and more, of approximately 4.5 million patients of Community Health Systems ranks as the second largest HIPAA breach ever, according to the Office of Civil Rights database.

The attack was committed by a Chinese group that accessed personal information. "This is no longer an 'if' it's going to happen, it's 'when,'" said Blake Wiedman a commercial insurance advisor focused in IT security in health care with Crichton Group.

Most HIPAA breaches have been the result of a lost laptop or other portable electronic device. "[T]his is the first breach of this magnitude and stye" said Jeff Miller, attorney with Harwell Howard Hyne Gabbert & Manner.

The fines for such breaches as well as the reputational consequences can be devastating. Taking proper precautions to avoid such breaches and being prepared in the event of a breach is a necessary part of doing business today. It is critical that all businesses have policies & procedures in place including employee training and proper data destruction.

Man in Tampa Accused of Stealing Patient ID Info

The documents with the Social Security numbers of veterans treated at the James A. Haley VA Medical Center in Tampa were supposed to be shredded by a company whose website warns, "Don't become a victim of identity theft."

The document shredding company, Secure Waste Disposal of Orlando, employed a 24 year old with a criminal history who kept those records out of the shredder and sold them to individuals who used the documents to file fraudulent tax returns. Secure Waste Disposal was under a contract with the Department of Veterans Affairs to shred documents for the Tampa hospital, prosecutors say.

The employee, Willie Streater, was arrested on eight charges accusing him of stealing the Social Security numbers of at least 34 veterans treated at the Hospital in 2011 and 2012. At least \$1.1 million was stolen.

The VA policy requires a criminal background check for employees but it is unclear if that policy extends to contractors like their shredding company.
